#### SECTION 6 SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS AND PRIVILEGES

Academic Scholarship Program-This scholarship is given to deserving students who excelled in their respective academic subjects.

- A. Entrance Scholarship
  - 1. Freshmen students who graduated valedictorians in high school are granted free tuition fees for one school year (two semesters and 1 summer) upon application and presentation of a certificate duly signed by the Principal of the school from where they graduated.

For those who are recipients of the Free Higher Education Provision, instead of free tuition fees for one school year, the qualified applicant is granted for one school year (two semesters and 1 summer) with the following:

Tangubanon Residents- a monthly stipend of P 500.00 Non-Tangubanon Residents- a monthly stipend of P 450.00

Upon application and with the following requirements:

- 1. Certificate as Class Valedictorian duly signed by the Principal of the school from where the applicant graduated
- 2. Certificate of General Weighted Average duly signed by the School Registrar
- 3. Certificate of Good Moral Character from where the applicant graduated
- 4. Certificate from the Barangay Captain from where the applicant resides.

Applicants will be screened based on the guidelines and slots set by the Institution.

2. Those who graduated salutatorians in high school are granted 50% discounts on tuition fees for one school year (two semesters and 1 summer) upon application and presentation of a certificate duly signed by the Principal of the school from where they graduated.

For those who are recipients of the Free Higher Education Provision, instead of free tuition fees for one school year, the qualified applicant is granted for one school year (two semesters and 1 summer) with the following:

Tangubanon Residents- a monthly stipend of P 400.00 Non-Tangubanon Residents- a monthly stipend of P 350.00

Upon application and with the following requirements:

- 1. Application Letter
- 2. Certificate as Class Salutatorian duly signed by the Principal of the school from where the applicant graduated

- 3. Certificate of General Weighted Average duly signed by the School Registrar
- 4. Certificate of Good Moral Character from where the applicant graduated
- 5. Certificate from the Barangay Captain from where that applicant resides.

Applicants will be screened based on the guidelines and slots set by the Institution.

B. GADTC Presidential Scholar. A scholarship is given to an honor student provided he carries a load of at least 18 units for every semester with no mark of "INC" or "DR" in all subjects.

A qualified applicant is entitled with the following:

- 1. A monthly stipend of Php 2,500.00 is granted to honor students with an average rating of at least 98% for two consecutive semesters provided that no grade is lower than 87%.
- 2. A monthly stipend of Php 1,800.00 is granted to honor students with an average rating of at least 94% for two consecutive semesters provided that no grade is lower than 87%.
- 3. A monthly stipend of Php 1,000.00 is granted to honor students with an average rating of at least 91% for two consecutive semesters provided that no grade is lower than 87%.
- LGU-Tangub Scholarship Program- This scholarship is supported by the Local Government of Tangub.
- A. **Barangay Scholarship:** Upon recommendation of a Barangay Captain in Tangub City and approval of the City Mayor, a barangay scholar is entitled to a P 600.00 monthly stipend after passing a qualifying examination, provided that the grantee does not incur a grade below 85% in all subjects in order to maintain this grant.
- B. **Barangay Grantee:** Upon recommendation of a Barangay Captain in Tangub City and approval of the City Mayor, a barangay grantee is entitled to a P 500.00 monthly stipend for the entire duration of his/her course, provided that the grantee does not incur grade below 80% in all subjects in order to maintain this grant.
- C. **Special Grants:** Special scholarship grants are offered to members in GADTC Performing Arts Group and GADTC Varsity team on the basis of their outstanding performances and provisions set by the College.

- E. **Panguil Bay Bigay Buhay Scholarship**-Special grant is offered to those sons and daughters of Tangubanon fishermen on the basis of their academic performance and provisions set by the Tangub City Local Government.
- F. SK Scholarship Program-An educational scholarship grant in pursuant to Local Government Code of 1991.
- G. Don Victoriano Scholarship/NCIP -A special grant is offered to those residents of Don Victoriano as per endorsement of the Local Government of Tangub.
- Alfonsos Scholarships Program- This refers to institutional non-academic scholarships with distinct talent or has contributory community work for the City Government of Tangub, province, region or in national level.
  - A. Alfonsos Student Assistant (ASA) Program. A scholarship that supports the poor but deserving students to finish their program and become good professionals to help them grow and develop as useful individuals and leaders while serving the needs of the communities.
    - 1. Application requirements:
      - a) Less privileged with an annual family income of not more that P 50,000.00
      - b) Accomplished Income Tax Return (ITR)
      - c) Application letter addressed to the College President thru the Scholarships and Welfare Office
      - d) Medical certificate of good health
      - e) Certificate of good moral character
      - f) Four (4) pieces 2x2 recent I.D. pictures
      - g) Form 137
      - h) Birth Certificate
      - i) Interview & other requirements as specified by the qualified committee.

Classified according to Working Scholars and Office Assistants

Academic Policies:

a) Alfonsos Student Assistant (ASA) are allowed to take a maximum load of 24 units per semester excluding ALWAY and NSTP depending upon their academic and work performance and evaluation. During

summer, Working Scholars are allowed to carry three (3) to six (6) units.

- b) Should render the vacant hours as duty per day during regular semester and during summer in offices or assigned areas as arranged by the Coordinator.
- c) Should attend any scheduled general cleaning and special work assignments provided it is for the College and the City or request to render service with the approval from the VP for Administration and Finance.

**Retention Policies:** 

- a) Renewal every semester
- b) Record of grades of the previous semester shall be submitted to the Scholarships and Welfare Office
- c) Working Scholars should pass all subjects enrolled; Office Assistants should pass all subjects enrolled and with a GWA of at least 80%.
- d) Evaluation shall be made by the Scholarships and Welfare Office on the grades and performances as per endorsement of the direct supervisor/offices assigned.
- e) Recommendation for renewal shall be noted by the VP for Academics and VP for Administration and Finance and shall be approved by the College President/City Mayor.
- 4. Alfonsos Student Assistant (ASA) Benefits/Advantages:

Qualified applicant is entitled to avail a board and lodging allowance provided that it is an accredited boarding house of the College with a monthly allowance based on the following rating obtained from the Performance Monitoring Tool:

- B. Editor-In-Chief and associate editor are granted 100% and Editorial staff are granted 50% discount on tuition fee only during the term of office. For those recipients of the Free Higher Education Provision Editor-in-Chief and staff can only avail the P 2,000.00 allowance per semester for living and/or book allowance during their term of office. Provided that they should maintain a general point average of 87% equivalent every semester to be determined by the adviser to be submitted to the Accounting Office.
- C. Mr. & Miss GADTC is granted 100% free tuition fee during his/her term. For those recipients of the Free Higher Education Provision can only avail the P 2,000.00 allowance per semester for living and/or book allowance during his/her term.
- D. Founding Anniversary Scholarship. Scholarship granted to students who represent the studentry during the search for Founding Anniversary King & Queen after winning in the screening procedures in the department level. They will enjoy a free tuition fee during their term. For those recipients of the Free Higher Education Provision can only avail the P 2,000.00 allowance per semester for living and/or book allowance during their term.
- E. Elected SSB and Local Student Board/Department Officers shall enjoy the following discounts in their tuition fees during their incumbency:

F. ROTC Corps Commander shall enjoy 100% free tuition fees during incumbency chargeable against 30% of the ROTC Trust Fund. ROTC Unit of the College shall follow the selection process for the ROTC Corps Commander. For those recipients of the Free Higher Education Provision can only avail the P 2,000.00 allowance per semester for living and/or book allowance during the term of office.

## Minimum Requirements for Alfonsos Scholarships:

- Applicant must be duly endorsed by the respective adviser(s), coach(es) or trainer specifying their grants availed depending on the performance for the current semester
- Should be enrolled within the minimum requirements of the program in a semester
- Should not obtained UD or more than two (2) INC grades in any subject including ALWAY and NSTP
- Certificate of Good Health from the College Clinic
- Must be a good character or no derogatory record as certified by the Office of the Prefect Discipline and Formation and Guidance and Admission Office

## Other Special Grants:

# A. Scholarships to GADTC Regular Employees' Dependents

The study grant consists of free tuition fee for academic programs offered in GADTC. Provided that, it is limited to the sons, daughters, legal husband, legal wife of regular employee of GADTC.

# B. Government Scholarship/Grants-in-Aid

Students may enjoy scholarships as provided by the law. These are some of the Government scholarships/grants-in-aid: CHED Scholarship, AFP, Local Government Units, Social Security System.

Number of Scholarships. A student can only enjoy one Scholarship Program of the City/College.

# **Deferment of Scholarship**-Deferment of scholarship may be permitted by reason of:

- a. Poor health or illness supported by a Medical Certificate issued by a government physician;
- b. Psychological or emotional problems with certification from the Guidance Counselor;
- c. Demise of parent;
- d. Other causes considered meritorious by the College President to be treated on a case to case basis.
- e. Deferment should not exceed one school year;
- f. After deferment, the grantee should then apply to the Scholarships and Welfare Office for reinstatement supported by a medical certificate that he/she is fit to resume studies.

# Termination of Scholarship-Grounds for termination:

- a. Scholastic deficiency
- b. Found guilty of a major offense case involving violation in school policies, rules and regulations.
- c. Membership/participation in any dissident organization
- d. Poor performance as per assessment by the coach/trainer/adviser/coordinator;
- e. Habitual absenteeism (supported by attendance during practice/performance/work assignments).
